Our Mission


Our mission is the prevention of cruelty to and the relief of suffering of animals.

The Organization

Founded in 1885, the Mobile Society for Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (Mobile SPCA) is a non-profit no-kill humane society and is one of the oldest continuously operating charitable organizations in Mobile and the country. The founding principles of the Society were to protect animals and children and to teach children kindness and respect for other living creatures. These principles are still valid today and, over 120 years later, remain the commitment of the Society.

The Society is a volunteer organization with a full-time humane officer and office manager. Memberships, donations and fund-raising projects are our only source of income. While the Mobile SPCA's name emphasizes one of our goals — prevention of cruelty to animals — the Society's activities cover a broad spectrum of animal-related topics.

Spay & Neuter Assistance

Pet overpopulation continues to be a major problem in Mobile. Many pet owners have refused to have their animals spayed or neutered because of the expense involved or because they are not aware of the health and behavior benefits associated with spaying and neutering. The Mobile SPCA works to educate pet owners about the importance of spaying and neutering their pets and assist them financially when necessary. The Mobile SPCA promotes the Maddie's Spay Neuter Project for owners on Medicaid and can provide others with financial aid. For more information contact the Mobile SPCA office.

Maddie's Pet Rescue Project

The Mobile SPCA is a member of the Maddie's Pet Rescue Project in Mobile County. The goal of the Project is to create a no-kill community in Mobile County by ending adoptable and treatable deaths in local animal shelters by 2014. Through the Project the Mobile SPCA removes animals from the local animal shelters and after vet care, spaying and neutering and microchipping, places them in loving homes.

Injured Animals

When an animal is injured and the Mobile SPCA is called, our first goal is to get the animal medical attention. Once the animal has been stabilized we attempt to locate the owner. If that proves to be impossible, the Mobile SPCA assumes responsibility for the decisions about care and placement of the animal. Countless pet owners have found their animals recovering beautifully from an emergency thanks to the Mobile SPCA's efforts.

Adoption & Foster Care

The Mobile SPCA runs an aggressive adoption program for homeless public and shelter animals. As well as the animals that are listed on petfinder.com, the Mobile SPCA has cats available daily at PETsMART, B&B Pet Stop and the Mobile SPCA office. Adoption clinics are held on a regular basis. All animals placed for adoption have been spayed or neutered, have been vet checked, microchipped and are current on vaccinations. Foster homes are also needed for animals the Mobile SPCA has for adoption. For more information on our adoption clinics, foster care, policies and procedures please contact the Mobile SPCA office.

Cruelty Investigation

Cruelty to animals is not only inhumane, it's illegal. With a full-time humane officer and volunteer cruelty investigator, the Mobile SPCA has been able to help educate people about the laws regarding cruelty to animals while making certain the current laws are enforced. We have been instrumental in the seizure of wantonly abused animals and the prosecution and conviction of their abusers.

If you suspect a case of animal cruelty call the Mobile SPCA office at 633-3531. We will help you reach the proper authorities and take over prosecution and investigation when all necessary city and county avenues have been explored.

Education

The SPCA works to educate people about issues ranging from applicable public ordinances to helping parents decide if their family is ready for a pet. The Society sponsors educational programs that cover the full range of pet ownership. Mobile SPCA speakers are available to schools, community and civic groups. The Mobile SPCA also maintains a series of public service announcements ranging from "hot car" warnings to jogging with your pet to what to do when a hurricane threatens.

Through our school program, Adopt-A-Teacher, the Mobile SPCA distributes *KIND News*, a monthly newspaper for students, to teachers in Mobile and surrounding counties.

Projects and Events

The Society holds several fund raising events throughout the year including our semi-annual rummage sale. Please call the Mobile SPCA office for information on upcoming events.

Since memberships, donations and fund-raising projects are our only source of income, volunteers are always needed to help with these special events.
